ISPCOP End of Term Report from President 2017-2021 Anupama Wadhwa

I took over as President from Dr. Roman Schumann in October 2017, at Seaport Hotel, Boston, MA. We were unable to identify President Elect at the time because of lack of interest. We had 13.000 dollars in cash reserves at the time.

In the last 4 years, we grew and did exceptionally well in certain areas like outreach and collaboration.

- 1. Collaborations with ASMBS and its leaders, IFSO and its leaders
- 2. Collaborations with Canadian Society of Anesthesiologists with help of Naveen Eipe
- 3. Created a MoU with the Brazilian Society of Anesthesiologists with help of Luiz Falcao
- 4. Maintained our relations with our European and British colleagues and most importantly created scholarly work as a group.
- 5. Created scholarly work in collaboration with other societies
- 6. Maintained our ongoing work with IARS with an annual ISPCOP symposium at the annual meeting
- 7. Had a strong presence at the ASA and had our annual ISPCOP symposium until Covid hit

On the other hand, we struggled in other areas. These could be our agenda items for growth as our lives potentially normalize over the next two years.

- 1. Membership growth-this especially suffered during Covid times
- 2. Website development-while we were struggling along with a website that worked through Vanessa (thanks to arrangements made by Stephanie Jones), we have had issues with the development of the new website. The biggest hurdle has been that our PayPal system does not accept any payments and we have not been able to get a new PayPal system up and running
- 3. Funds-In 2018, we were hit with big expenses of the meeting as the expected funding did not come through. We were unable to have a symposium last year due to covid, which is our biggest revenue generator. This has kept us at the current cash reserve of 11,000 dollars
- 4. While we started discussions about reciprocal memberships with ESPCOP and SOBA, we never reached an agreement
